Items accepted

Fiction & nonfiction books,
preferably less than 15 years old

Magazines less than 2 years old
(exception: National Geographics)

Children's books, CDs, DVDs

Audiobooks on CDs (complete sets only)

Music CDs in good condition

Movie DVDs in good condition

Items NOT accepted

Worn, torn, damaged or
soiled books or other items

Books that are mildewed,
moldy, dirty (stained), or
have musty or tobacco odors

Encyclopedias

VHS or cassette tapes

Activity books (such as
crosswords) that have been
written in

All sale proceeds benefit the Bellingham Public Library

Donations accepted during open hours at:

Branch libraries – one box per person, per day
